



02 Fire safety policy

Alongside associated procedures in 02.01 to 02.03 Fire safety, this policy was adopted by Little Doves Christian Pre-School on 2nd September 2021, reviewed in August 2022 and July 2023.

The list of designated fire marshals is on the parent noticeboard at Little Doves.

Aim

Little Doves CP is a suitable, clean and safe place for children to be cared for, where they can grow and learn. All statutory requirements about fire safety are met and the criteria for meeting the relevant Early Years Foundation Stage Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements are fulfilled.

Objectives

- Little Doves CP recognises that it has a corporate responsibility and a duty of care for those who work in and receive a service from the provision but individual employees and service users also have a responsibility to ensure their own safety as well as that of others. Risk assessment is the key means through which this is achieved.
- A fire safety risk assessment is carried out by a competent person in accordance with the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.
- A Fire Safety Log is completed and regularly updated.
- Necessary equipment is in place to promote fire safety.
