Slight Healthy Snack Increase

As you are all aware, food prices have rocketed and so reluctantly we have had to increase our Healthy Snack charge by 10p to £1.35. We have also had to introduce an afternoon healthy snack charge of £0.25 for children who stay beyond 2pm.

Remember to renew your codes for January 2026 to continue to receive 30 hour and working two year old funding
