To all our parents & carers,

Welcome to all our new families who have started with us recently - it has been lovely getting to know you all. How wonderful it is to see the sunshine after a long winter - we had the gazebo out today for the first time ©

This has been such a strange time to work in childcare. It is lovely we have been able to start getting back to normal however we are still struggling with illness in the children and staff. Covid has not gone away and now we are also dealing with all the normal illnesses such as tummy bugs and colds. Please remember if your child is sick or has diarrhoea, they need to be 48 hours clear from the last episode before returning to Little Doves. If you test positive for Covid, please still isolate as per the government's instructions.

Because of staff shortages due to illnesses, some days we are very stretched so PLEASE remember to pick up on time and PLEASE phone ahead if you are unavoidably detained. Staff have their own children to pick up and we have to be put away and out of the building promptly.

Little Doves is still advertising for supply staff; a suitable person to join our team who is flexible and can cover all parts of the day. If you can recommend anyone that would be wonderful. For more details see the advert on the reverse page.

You will have received an email/letter saying that our lunch club fee and half term voluntary donation will be increasing after Easter holidays to £4 and £20 respectively.
